



POLICY of OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY, HEALTH, AND ENVIRONMENT UNIVERSITAS ISLAM INDONESIA

The Universitas Islam Indonesia (UII) is committed to conducting educational, research, and community service activities, as well as all university supporting activities, by prioritizing occupational safety, health, and environmental aspects (OSHE) in order to create a campus environment that is safe, healthy, comfortable, sustainable, and conducive for the entire academic community and other parties carrying out activities within the UII campus.

To fulfill this commitment, the UII management is determined to:

1. Integrate OSHE aspects into UII's governance and all its activities.
2. Comply with applicable laws, regulations, standards, and other requirements related to OSHE.
3. Establish, implement, maintain, and continuously improve the performance of the OSHE management system.
4. Proactively mitigate and control OSHE risks that may occur on the UII campus.
5. Protect and manage the environment responsibly.
6. Providing and enhancing the competence and quality of human resources in the field of OSHE.
7. Creating a safe, healthy, inclusive, and conducive campus environment to promote the implementation and improvement of OSHE performance.
8. Ensuring the campus capacity for emergency preparedness and responses.

This policy serves as the foundation for all work units within the UII campus in establishing OSHE goals, objectives, programs, procedures, and activities in accordance with the characteristics and risk levels of each unit. This policy is communicated to the UII academic community, made available to external parties, and reviewed periodically to ensure its relevance to the UII organizational context, OSHE risks, and relevant OSHE regulations and standards.
